Maxine explained why some activities were not suitable to the school due to our special character and also the safety aspect. Good fundraisers that were simple were the sausage sizzles and the ice block sales. <p><b><u>School Cultural Festival Fundraiser</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Food - \$6 per plate</li> <li>• Cultural food for kids</li> <li>• Other ideas</li> </ul> <p>The PTA will fundraise at this event. The school will let Subway know that there will be no lunch ordering on this day. Children will buy plates from the PTA. A vegetarian option is to be made available. Each plate will have food typical of our three main cultures – tongan, samoan and cook island with the sausage sizzle for our kiwi culture.
